



The Basics

- Because of Covid-19 we'll be using a virtual format.
- SST will be held on Thursday, November 12, 2020 at 7pm via this twitch.TV channel
- We will keep categories the same as last year, being:
 - Furniture and cabinets,
 - Boxes and bowls, and
 - Accessories, toys, and tools
- Note: Projects can only be entered in a single category.



Furniture and Cabinets

- Tables, chairs, and seating
- Chests, dressers, beds
- Desks and bookcases
- China, display (curio) cabinets, buffets, and sideboards
- Kitchen cabinets, vanities, entertainment centers, and built-ins



Boxes and Bowls

- Jewelry and keepsake boxes
- Turned and cut (jig saw or CNC) bowls
- Tea caddies and spice boxes
- Urns



Accessories, Toys, and Tools

- Decorative accessories such as mirrors, clocks, lamps, picture frames, Intarsia, etc.
- Pyrography and carvings (unless attached to furniture)
- Audio speakers
- Children's toys
- Self constructed hand or stationary tools including: wood planes, jigs, multi-routers, and CNC routers
- Anything that doesn't fit in the first two categories



Eligibility

- All current Guild members are encouraged to participate. There is no limit to the number of projects that can be entered in each category
- Guild members may submit and present their project, but may choose not to enter it for judging
- To submit a project for judging it must be received by Midnight, Sunday, November 8th
- You may submit your SST entry beginning after this meeting
- If projects are mixed media, then 51% of the project must be constructed out of wood. Glass, epoxy, metal, plastic, canvas, etc. are all acceptable secondary materials



Awards

- 8 awards will be presented as follows:
 - 1. Furniture and Cabinets - 1st place
 - 2. Furniture and Cabinets - 2nd place
 - 3. Boxes and Bowls - 1st place
 - 4. Boxes and Bowls - 2nd place
 - 5. Accessories, Toys, and Tools - 1st place
 - 6. Accessories, Toys, and Tools - 2nd place
 - 7. Best of Show
 - 8. Peoples Choice

Submissions

- Submissions will be by way of pictures, narratives and/or videos
- Please submit a minimum of 3 pictures: front, side, top. More if you want to point out particular details.
- A description is required. It can be either:
 - Video's are highly recommended (we want to hear from you). Limit to 5 minutes.
 - Written narratives will be accepted

- Note: Good quality pictures and narratives can win the game. We've all experience this before: A mediocre project that has high quality pictures and a great story can oftentimes beat a masterfully executed project that has poor pictures.

Judging

- A project which receives an award in any of the three categories may also receive an award in the Best of Show and/or Peoples Choice.
- First and second place in categories will be decided by the number of votes received (ballots will not have 1st and 2nd place choices).
- In the event of a tie for any of the 8 awards multiple awards will be given. A tie for first place will not preclude a 2nd place from being awarded.
- Judging will be done by members using Survey Monkey. Votes must be returned by the EOD Sunday, November 15th.
- Spouses vote for The People's Choice Award. Spouses to email us their choice (not survey monkey) to Mike Kozikowski.
- Results will be announced at the virtual Christmas Party.
